

# THE SELECTION PROCESS - SIBC EAST AFRICA ENERGY TRANSITION

## 1 Preselection | Verify the eligibility of candidates

- Before the jury phase, the campus will check the applications to confirm they meet the eligibility criteria
  - 1.The organization has been legally registered for at least 3 years in 1 of the 5 countries of the program (Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Rwanda & Ethiopia) and has potential for scale-up ;
  - 2.The project is partially funded by income generated from commercial activities ;
  - 3.The project has a demonstrated social and environmental mission, advocates for the energy transition, and offers an innovative solution or business model ;
  - 4.The project falls under one of the eligible sub-sectors : access to energy (on-grid/off-grid), clean cooking solutions, renewable energy, energy efficiency, or energy sufficiency.

## 2 Local juries | Opening the selection phase to entrepreneurial actors from East Africa

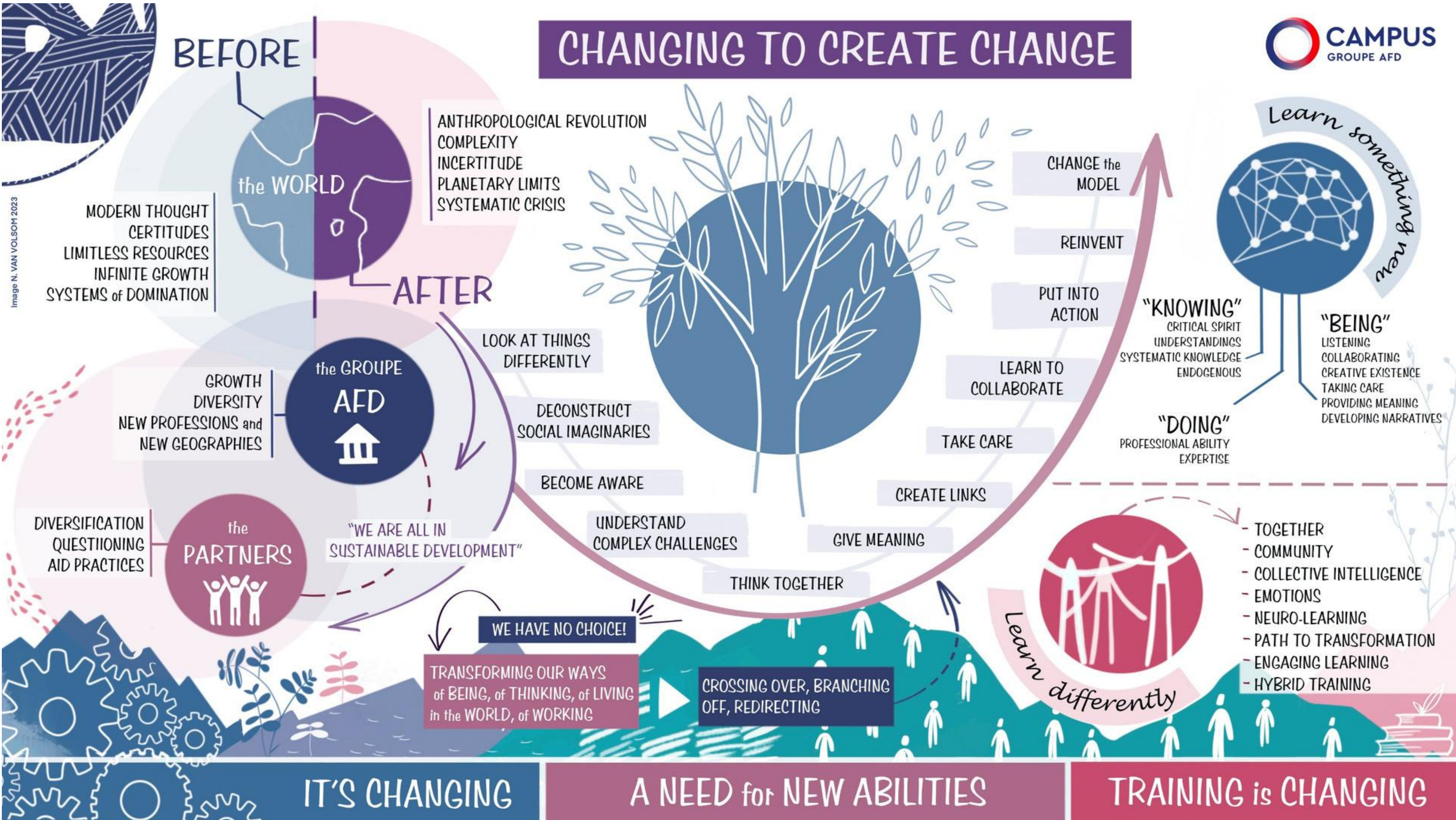
- Identify the 50 innovative and impact entrepreneurs from East Africa who will be supported by the SIBC, based on 3 evaluation criteria : impact, innovation and scale-up potential
- Meet the local actors of social entrepreneurship and consolidate a supportive and engaged community

## 3 Validation committee

- Ensure the overall coherence of the promotion, in terms of language, geographical distribution and sector

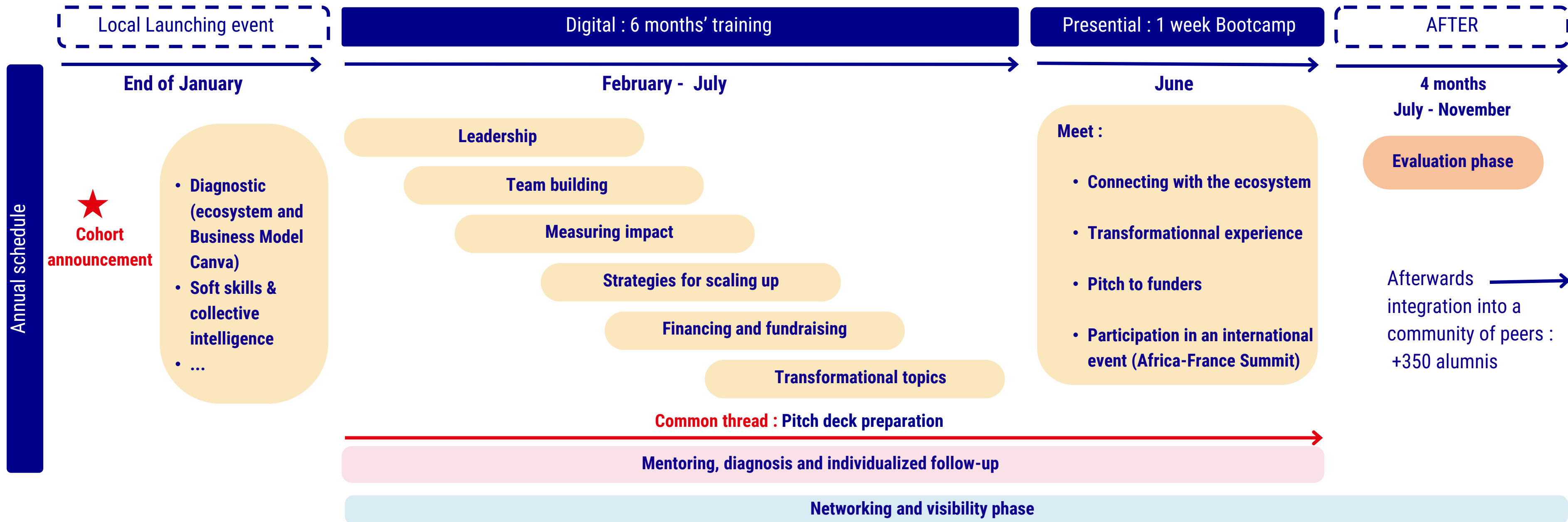
