

Statement on Honour

The candidate hereby declares in their honour :

Final convictions :

- Not to have been the subject, within the past five years, of a final conviction for any of the offences provided for under Articles 222-38, 222-40, 225-1, 226-13, 313-1 to 313-3, 314-1 to 314-3, 324-1 to 324-6, 413-9 to 413-12, 421-1 to 421-2-3, the second paragraph of Article 421-5, Article 433-1, the second paragraph of Article 433-2, the eighth paragraph of Article 434-9, the second paragraph of Article 434-9-1, Articles 435-3, 435-4, 435-9, 435-10, 441-1 to 441-7, 441-9, 445-1 and 450-1 of the French Criminal Code, Article 1741 of the French General Tax Code, Articles L. 2339-2 to L. 2339-4, L. 2339-11-1 to L. 2339-11-3 of the French Defence Code and Article L. 317-8 of the French Internal Security Code, or for offences of a similar nature in another Member State of the European Union;
- Not to be excluded from public procurement contracts, whether as a principal or additional penalty imposed by a criminal court, pursuant to Articles 131-10 or 131-39 of the French Criminal Code;

Fight against illegal work :

- Not to have been the subject, within the past five years, of a conviction recorded in bulletin No. 2 of the criminal record for the offences referred to in Articles L. 8221-1, L. 8221-3, L. 8221-5, L. 8231-1, L. 8241-1, L. 8251-1 and L. 8251-2 of the French Labour Code, or for offences of a similar nature in another Member State of the European Union;

Employment obligation regarding disabled workers or equivalent : For public procurement contracts and framework agreements subject to the Public Procurement Code, to have complied, during the year preceding the launch of the procurement procedure, with Articles L. 5212-1 to L. 5212-11 of the French Labour Code concerning the employment of disabled workers;

Judicial liquidation : Not to be subject to judicial liquidation proceedings as provided for in Article L. 640-1 of the French Commercial Code, not to be subject to personal bankruptcy under Articles L. 653-1 to L. 653-8 of the same Code, and not to be subject to any equivalent proceedings governed by foreign law;

Judicial reorganisation : not to be admitted to judicial reorganisation proceedings as provided for in Article L. 631-1 of the French Commercial Code or to any equivalent proceedings governed by foreign law, or, where applicable, to provide evidence of authorization to continue business operations for the foreseeable duration of performance of the public contract or framework agreement

Tax and social security status : as of 31 December of the year preceding the launch of the procurement procedure, to have filed all required tax and social declarations and paid all due taxes and social security contributions, or to have settled such taxes and contributions voluntarily before the date of the launch of this procedure, or to have provided guarantees deemed sufficient by the competent authority responsible for collection;

Gender equality :

- Not to have been the subject, within the past five years, of a conviction recorded in bulletin No. 2 of the criminal record for the offences referred to in Article L. 1146-1 of the French Labour Code;
- As of 31 December of the year preceding the launch of the procurement procedure, to have complied with the obligation to negotiate provided for in Article L. 2242-5 of the French Labour Code or, failing that, to have remedied or initiated the process of remedying this situation at the date of submission;
