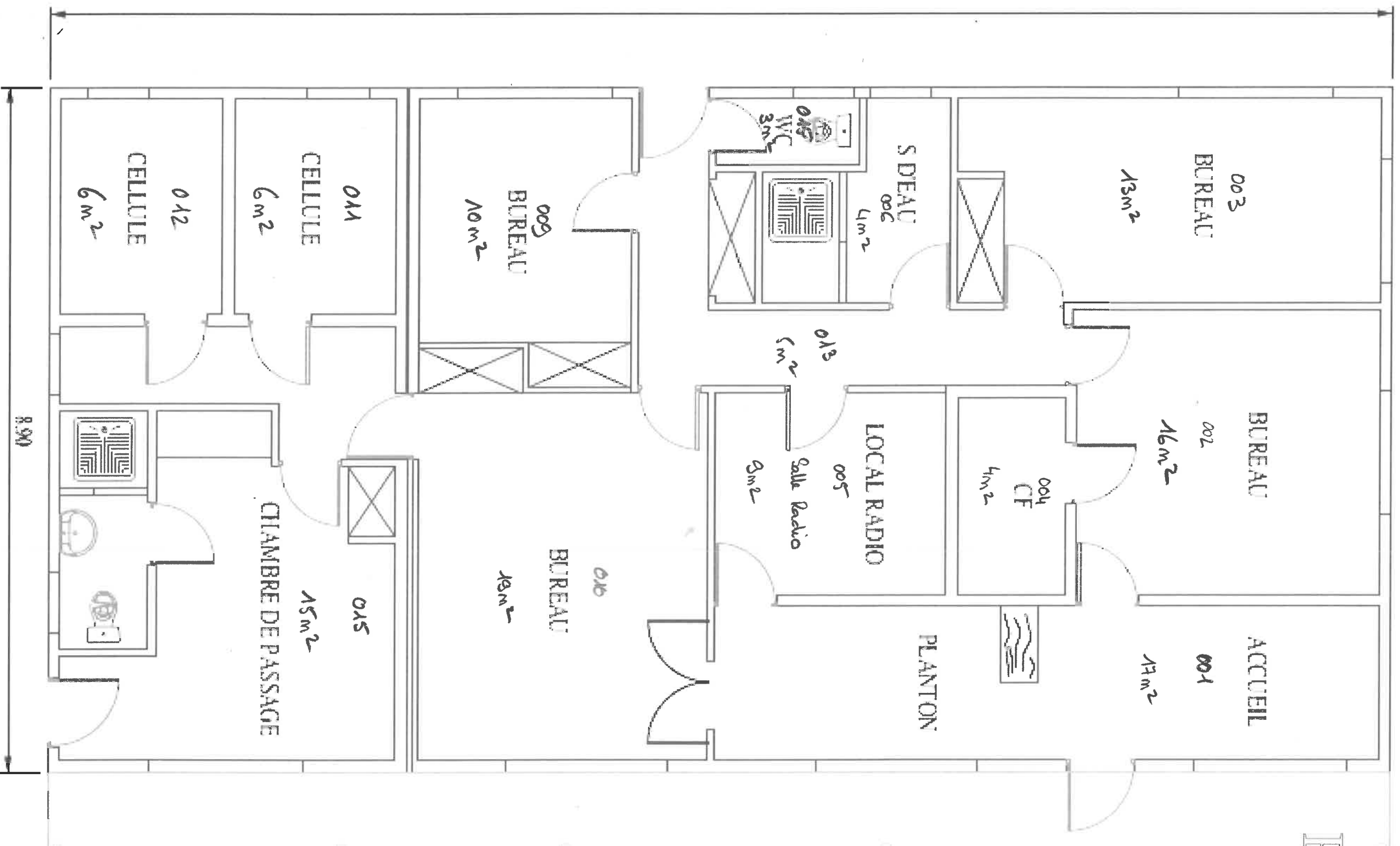


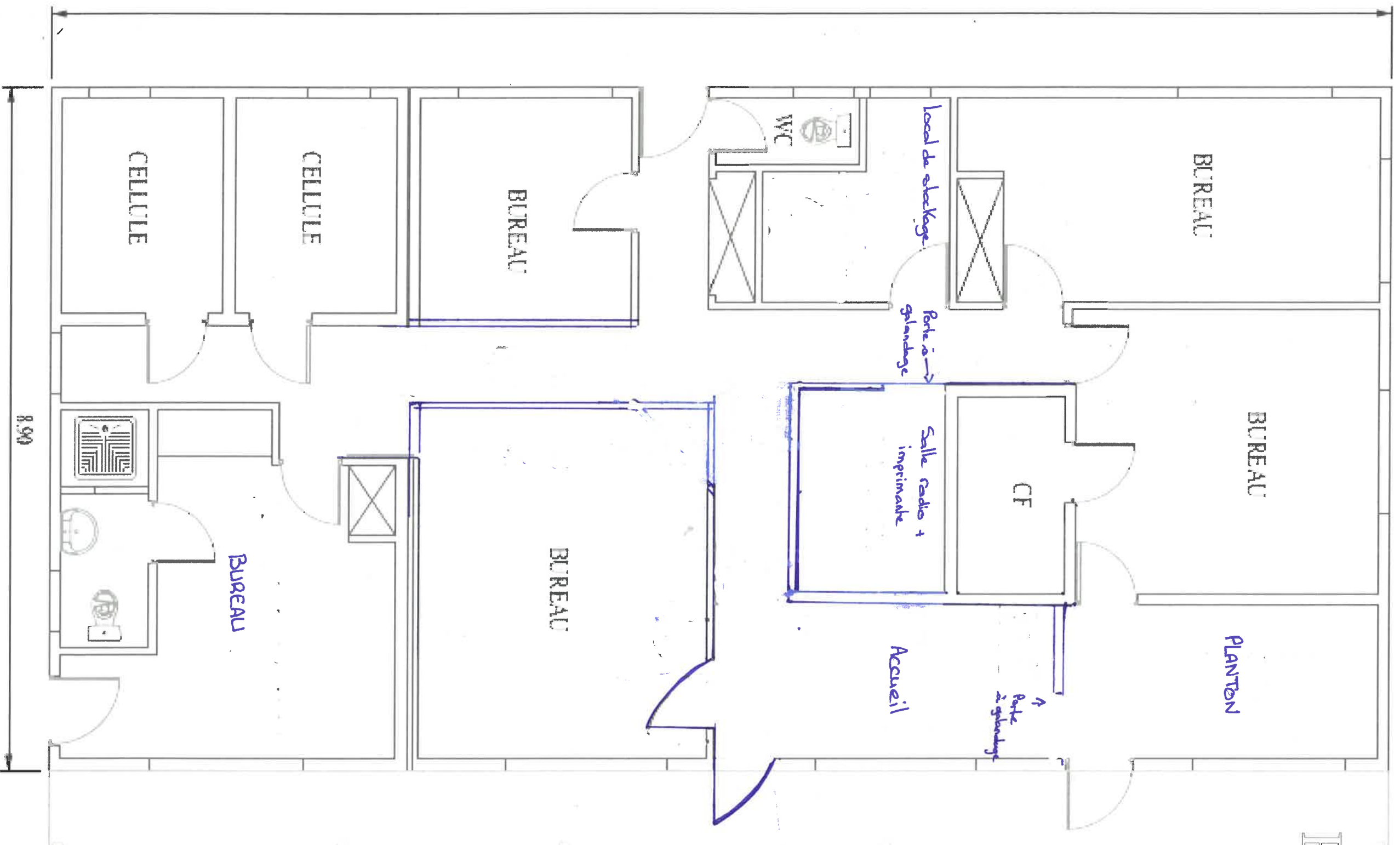


DIRECTION MIXTE DES TRAVAUX DE POLYNESIE

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The graph illustrates the projected increase in the aging population across several nations. Japan starts at approximately 18% in 1980 and rises to nearly 25% by 2020. The United States begins at about 10% and reaches 15%. Germany and France show similar trends, starting around 12% and reaching 18%. Italy starts at 14% and increases to 20%. The United Kingdom and Canada follow a similar path, starting at 11% and reaching 16%. The Soviet Union starts at 10% and reaches 14%. The People's Republic of China shows the most dramatic increase, starting at 5% and reaching 12%.
